

SELF-DRIVE DIRECTIONS FROM ROCKTAIL CAMP TO JOHANNESBURG VIA JOZINI

You are responsible for all required paperwork and relevant costs.

Please ensure that your mobile phones are set up with International Roaming from your country of origin (to both dial out and to receive calls or texts) to facilitate ease of communications in the event of an emergency, while travelling in South Africa. Should you choose to purchase and use a local SIM card within your mobile phone, this will not apply.

All directions provided are correct to the best of our knowledge. Due to circumstances beyond our control, signage may disappear, and roads may become damaged, resulting in unforeseen detours or delays.

Prior to departing on safari, please provide Maputaland Travel with the relevant arrival and departure details, as well as a contact number.

Should you not arrive at Rocktail Camp due to losing your way, becoming stranded or experiencing technical difficulties with your vehicle, it is not the responsibility of Maputaland Travel to recover or search for you. That being said, we will do everything possible to facilitate the hiring of someone to recover and/or assist you. All costs incurred will be for your own account and Maputaland Travel cannot be held liable for any delays or missed services.

Maputaland Travel will not accept any liability, responsibility or claim for compensation, for any incident or accident involving you, your vehicle and/or any third party. If hiring a car, requirements may vary depending on country and/or car-hire company. We highly recommend that you are covered by comprehensive travel insurance as per our booking terms and conditions.

The Manzengwenya Park access gate into the Maputaland Coastal Forest Reserve is open from 06h00 and closes at 18h00. It is not possible to enter the Reserve, nor exit from the Reserve, outside of these operating hours. Due to park regulations, there can be no movement of vehicles (transfer vehicles or self-drive vehicles) outside of these times.

Scheduled complimentary transfers from Rocktail Camp to Coastal Cashews:

- These transfers depart Rocktail Camp at 09h30, 12h00 and 14h00.
- Please note: as the camp is a 40-minute drive away, these transfers will only run when a transfer has been booked – i.e. they will not run if there is no booking for a departure.
- All 2x4 self-drive guests must advise reservations which departure transfer times ex-Rocktail Camp they will be using, at least 72 hours prior to arrival in camp, to avoid the cost of a private transfer.



- From Coastal Cashews turn left onto the D1849 (gravel road) and continue for approximately 5 kilometres.
- At the T-Junction turn right onto the R22 in the direction of “Kwangwanase and Farazella”.
- Travel for approximately 15 kilometres and you will come to two roundabouts (traffic circles). Continue straight at the first roundabout and turn left at the second roundabout onto “P522” towards Tembe National Elephant Park.
- You will pass Tembe National Elephant Park on the right-hand side of the road, as well as the turn-off for Ndumu Game reserve on the right. Continue and drive through an unmanned veterinary control gate. Continue for approximately 30 kilometres until you get to a petrol station on your left-hand side. There is a road to the left, immediately after the petrol station and a sign pointing to Jozini. Turn left onto the P522.
- Travel for approximately 40 kilometres, go over the Jozini Dam Wall (Pongolapoort Dam) and into the town of Jozini.
- You arrive at a T-junction, turn right, and drive through the town of Jozini. This road will take you down a mountain pass and it is approximately 18 kilometres to the T-junction.
- At the T-junction turn right, this is the N2 towards Pongola.
- From Pongola, follow the N2 to Piet Retief (approximately 100 kilometres).
- From Piet Retief, follow the signage pointing in the direction of Ermelo, on the N2 which is approximately 100 kilometres.
- From Ermelo, look out for signage stating “Bethal” and follow the N17 to Bethal which is approximately 50 kilometres.
- Continue on the N17 through Bethal towards Springs.
- Follow the N17 to Springs / Brakpan / Boksburg and Johannesburg. Follow all signage for the N1 Pretoria, which will be via the N3.

There are five toll gates as you travel towards to Johannesburg. Per vehicle type costs (standard sedan, motorcycle, truck, etc.) are subject to change without prior notification.
